PA Turnpike to Exit #110, Somerset. From Somerset take Route 219 North to the Elton Exit, PA 756. At the end of the exit ramp, turn right. At light turn right onto Theater Drive (Sleep Inn and Comfort Inn on your right). At the third light turn left onto Schoolhouse Road. Get into the left lane. At light, go straight. Make first right onto Picking Drive. Proceed to stop sign. The Living/Learning Center is straight ahead.

January's Meeting Summary Report

Last month, we had another great presentation at Anthony's Restaurant in Johnstown. The presentation, given by Professor Bill Bahnfleth of Penn State University, began with his recounting of the commonly held concept of the efficient chilled water system being a water-cooled primary/ secondary or primary/secondary/tertiary system with parallel chillers. As Bill explained, during the past decade, operational problems with this approach, technology developments, and out-of-the-box thinking by designers and manufacturers have called into question virtually every assumption of this approach. One of the most-discussed alternatives to primary/secondary design is variable primary flow, but it is far from the only new development. Decentralized pumping; more widespread use of variable speed drives on pump, tower, and compressor motors; series chiller arrangements, novel control schemes, and other options confront the system designer with a potentially baffling array of alternatives. Mr. Bahnfleth's presentation focused mainly on variable primary flow, but also touched on some of these other emerging trends and how they may help the chilled water plants of the future achieve much better performance.

UPDATE ON PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT REQUIREMENTS IN PENNSYLVANIA

As reported in the December/January edition of THE NEWS, Senate Bill 655 was signed by Governor Rendell in November, and this means that Pennsylvania joins the list of states that will require continuing professional development (CPD) as a condition of license renewal. We have received some updated information on this from our friends at the Pennsylvania Society of Professional Engineers (PSPE) and would like to share this with you, in case you haven't already heard it. In the last article, we noted that Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors and Geologists would need to obtain 24 credit hours of continuing education each licensing period (2 years). The details as to what coursework or education is acceptable and accredited will need to be developed by the State Board which, under the terms of the Act, has 18 months to do so. It is likely that the necessary regulations will be similar to those adopted in other states which require continuing education and could follow the already-established National Council of Examiners for Engineers and Surveyors (NCEES) model. Another aspect to consider is the timing of the legislation. PE licenses will be up for renewal this year. Since the State Board has 18 months to develop the requirements of the program, this will not affect PE renewals until the following period (2009), which will most likely be the first renewal that will have the verification of continuing education requirements. In any event, Pennsylvania has taken a major step forward in this area, and we will keep you posted on developments as they occur.
